## Being a by-law to regulate <u>burining</u> within the limits of St. Jean-Baptiste, Letellier, St. Joseph BY-LAW NO. 556/97 RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MONTCALM

WHEREAS the Council of the R.M. of Montcalm deems it necessary and in the best interests of the LUD of St. Jean, town of Letellier & St. Joseph to regulate and control burning of materials within their limits,

by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters: AND WHEREAS Subsection 232(1) of the Municipal Act of Manitoba states in part "A council may pass

- $\widehat{\mathbb{C}}$ preventing and fighting fires, the enforcement of by-laws."

MOM THEREFORE the Council of the R.M. of Montcalm enacts as follows:

- Jean, Letellier, St. Joseph. THAT there shall be no open, uncontained fires allowed within the limits of the towns of St.
- to under the THAT property owners wishing to construct a "fire pit" for recreational uses may be allowed following conditions:
- ಲ THAT the concrete/cinder block, "fire pit" shall be made from either a heavy gauge steel or
- J THAT the "fire pit" shall be a minimum of eight (8) inches in height, and
- C buildings and a minimum of fifteen (15) feet from any property line. THAT the "fire pit" shall be located a minimum of twenty-five (25) feet from any

- THAT property owners wishing to use a "fire pit" shall ensure that:

  a) The "fire pit" must only be used for burning solid fuel products. Garbage and/or recyclables as well as lawn clippings, leaves, and any other compostable material shall not be burnt in said "fire pit",
- <u>5</u> Any fire shall be extinguished prior to being left unattended.
- 4. THAT any existing "fire pits" will be deemed to be in computance will ull by-law, however if the said "fire pit" does not meet the above yard requirements, the Fire Chief shall have the discretion to either allow the said "fire pit" to remain or demand that it comply with the above requirements, depending on the individual yards landscaping and building features. THAT any existing "fire pits" will be deemed to be in compliance with this by-law, however
- 5. THAT any person(s) in contravention of any portion of this by-law shall be liable to pay a fine to the R.M. of Montcalm of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first offence, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second offence, seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for the third offence and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each succeeding offence.
