News from the LUD

In a previous newsletter, the LUD announced some upgrades to Centre Avenue, east of Caron Street. Dubbed the 4 Corners Project, there will be a "Welcome to Saint-Jean-Baptiste" sign with associated landscape work, curbing, and plants on the northeast corner. On the south side of Centre, complete the excavation work started in 2020, include a sidewalk promenade, curbing, lighting, landscaping, trees and shrubs. This work is scheduled to commence in July.

Because of Covid-19, there are unique one-time grant opportunities encouraging communities to create or adapt outdoor public spaces to allow for socially distanced activities.

Without going into great detail, the LUD is seizing this opportunity to apply for funding that would create a winding walking trail from the deck of the Red River bridge west of Railway Avenue, then connecting with another pathway west of Caron outside the dike around the pond on the north end of town. This project is contingent on a successful grant application.

BURN BAN

Due to dry conditions and the current weather forecast calling for warm temperatures and high winds, the Rural Municipality of Montcalm has implemented a burn ban effective June 3, 2021.

This ban targets the intentional setting of fires in grass, brush, stubble etc. Including agricultural burning. Fires enclosed in backyard fire pits are not permitted at this time. Enclosed barbeques are permitted.

The burn ban will be in place until conditions improve and is cancelled by the Fire Chiefs and the CAO.

2021 Property Taxes

The 2021 Property Tax Bills have arrived and we are working hard at sending them out as quickly as possible! This year, the tax due date is Sunday, October 31, 2021.

> If you pay your property taxes early, you get an early payment discount! 1.00 % for the month of June & July 2021 0.75 % for the month of August 2021 0.25 % for the month of September 2021

This year your taxes may look a little different as the Manitoba government is providing tax relief to Manitobans by introducing a multi-year phased elimination of education property taxes. Starting in 2021, as a property owner in Manitoba, you will receive the Education Property Tax Rebate to reduce a portion of your education property taxes.

This applies to residential properties including single dwelling units, condos and multiple unit dwellings. Farm property owners must still apply for the Farmland School Tax Rebate.

Owners of other properties (such as commercial, industrial, railway, institutional and designated recreational) will receive a 10% rebate of the total of both the school division special levy and the education support levy pavable.

. The Education Property Tax Rebate cheques will arrive before October 31,2021.

Building Permits

Did you know you require a permit for:

- Repairing of foundations
- \Diamond Grain bins & machine shops
- Demolition, removal or partial removal of buildings or structures
- ♦ **Fence**
- \Diamond Hot tubs / Pools
- \Diamond Decks

You do not need a permit for:

- Replacement of stucco, siding or shingles \Diamond
- Replacement of doors when the opening is not enlarged or reduced in size.
- Patching, painting & decorating

Do you have lands east of the Red River that are wet and difficult to manage? Receive payments for transitioning cultivated land to grassland and providing water retention. SRRWD funds up to a maximum of \$100/acre based on assessed land value, plus establishment costs.
