Animal Control



A reminder for residents who have household domestic animals to remember the following:

Pick up after your animal to help keep our communities clean and safe. No owner or person in charge of an animal shall allow it to run at large. All dogs over 4 months of age are to be licensed and all household animals should have their vaccinations up to date at all times. No person shall own, harbor, keep or have on their premises more than 3 dogs or 5 cats at any time (over the age of 4 months).

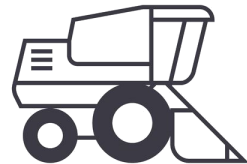

In each newsletter, the public works department will bring you a bit of information about what is currently underway or what is coming up from the public works side of the RM.

In the next few months, council will be doing readings of a new by-law to implement tipping fees at the nuisance grounds. Fees will be based on type and amounts of materials. We will be expanding the types of items that we can recycle, and the items that can be burnt will be different.

It is very important to have your materials sorted – household garbage, metal, electronics, oil, and clean burnable are just some of the categories of what we can accept. If you want further information on sorting your items please speak to Chris, the attendant at the facility.
