## **News from the LUD**

Several projects are getting some attention recently. The sidewalk at the south end of Caron Street has been poured. Final grading and driveway rehabilitation remains to be completed.

The 4 Corners Project is well underway. A Manitoba Infrastructure crew completed work on the bridge abutment in order to prepare it for new pedestrian-friendly railings. The railings are in the process of being installed. Once completed, the unsight-

ly barricade will be removed and safety bollards installed to allow access to pedestrians. Work has begun on both sides of Centre Avenue. You will note that the Coop gas pump is no longer accessible from Centre Avenue. The northeast corner in front of Jablonski Electrical, Plumbing & Heating will feature a Welcome to Saint-Jean-Baptiste sign. The sign's design by RPM Graphyx is a tribute to our dearly missed Red River Bridge. On the south side of Centre Avenue, there will be a new driveway to access the church parking lot. This area will feature a wide concrete pad, lighting, trees, shrubs, river rock, and benches. The LUD successfully secured a \$50,000 contribution through the Manitoba Build-

ing Sustainable Communities grant and another \$7,000 through a Manitoba Sport, Culture & Heritage program. We are awaiting word on other grant applications.

## <u>APPLE CRISP RECIPE:</u>

#### **Ingredients**

- 4 medium apples, cubed or sliced (4 cups)
- 3/4 cup brown sugar  $\Diamond$
- 1/2 cup all purpose flour  $\Diamond$
- 1/2 cup quick-cooking or old fashioned oats
- 1/3 cup butter, softened  $\Diamond$
- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 3/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

#### Steps:

- 1.Heat oven to 375°F. Grease bottom and sides of 8-inch square pan with shortening.
- 2.Spread apples in pan. In medium bowl, stir remaining ingredients until well mixed; sprinkle over apples.
- 3.Bake about 30 minutes or until topping is golden brown and apples are tender when pierced with a fork. Serve warm with cream or ice cream!
