#### Public Works Manager Tidbit

From wet to dry... We started out this spring with high water levels again but were fortunate that the weather cooperated, and we avoided a major flood event. We have been working hard to restore infrastructure from the 2022 flood, as well as perform repairs stemming from damage this spring. During this time several roads have been rebuilt, ditches cleaned, and culverts replaced. We are still working towards completing many of these repairs along with normal operations. Since the high waters this spring, most of the RM has received very little rain. This has created different challenges for our RM and its utilities, and is making the dirt and gravel roads very dusty, creating dangerous situations at times.

As crews work to restore infrastructure and rate payers work in the RM with large equipment, please use caution on all roadways.



#### **Hot Dog Mummies**

- 1 Can crescent rolls
- 2 1/2 slices of cheese, quartered
- 10 Hot dogs
- Cooking Spray
- White & Black cookie icing
- Mustard & Ketchup for dipping
- 1. Preheat oven to 375
- 2. Unroll crescent rolls & separate
- 3. Cut each rectangle of dough into 10 long strips of dough & quarter the cheese slices into 4 long strips
- 4. Put a slice of cheese lengthwise on each hotdog. Use 4 strips of dough to wrap each hotdog up like a mummy.
- 5. Place each mummy onto a baking sheet, cheese side down. Spray tops lightly with cooking spray.
- 6. Bake 15-17 minutes until golden brown
- 7. To make eyes, squirt drop of white icing and a drop of black icing
